ILLINOIS HEALTH AND HOSPITAL ASSOCIATION MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: IHA Update: State Requirement on Education of Unvaccinated Staff Members

The Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) issued an <u>emergency rule</u> on September 24 requiring each hospital to provide all of its <u>unvaccinated</u> staff members with 90 minutes of "clear and accurate instruction" regarding COVID-19 vaccines. The education must address vaccine effectiveness, benefits, risks, common reactions, hesitancy and misinformation. [The emergency rule was published in the <u>October 1 Illinois Register</u>, pages 11907-11923.]

IHA has been advised by IDPH that the training provision of the emergency rule is an attempt to try different angles to get people vaccinated and they understand hospital administrators are doing their best to vaccinate as many staff as possible. IHA has continually been advised that, as long as hospitals are pursuing these activities to the best of their ability, good faith efforts to comply will be satisfactory.

IHA has further been led to believe that approximately 90 minutes of educational material, written, audio or video, could simply be emailed to unvaccinated employees and those employees could attest to having reviewed the materials. IHA has been given every indication this action would satisfy the "spirit" of the rule and would represent a good faith effort to supplement the significant educational efforts that hospitals have already been undertaking over the last 10 months to persuade employees to receive the vaccine.

To assist members, IHA has compiled an array of existing COVID-19 vaccine education resources, combinations of which could be used to satisfy the requirements of the emergency rule.
